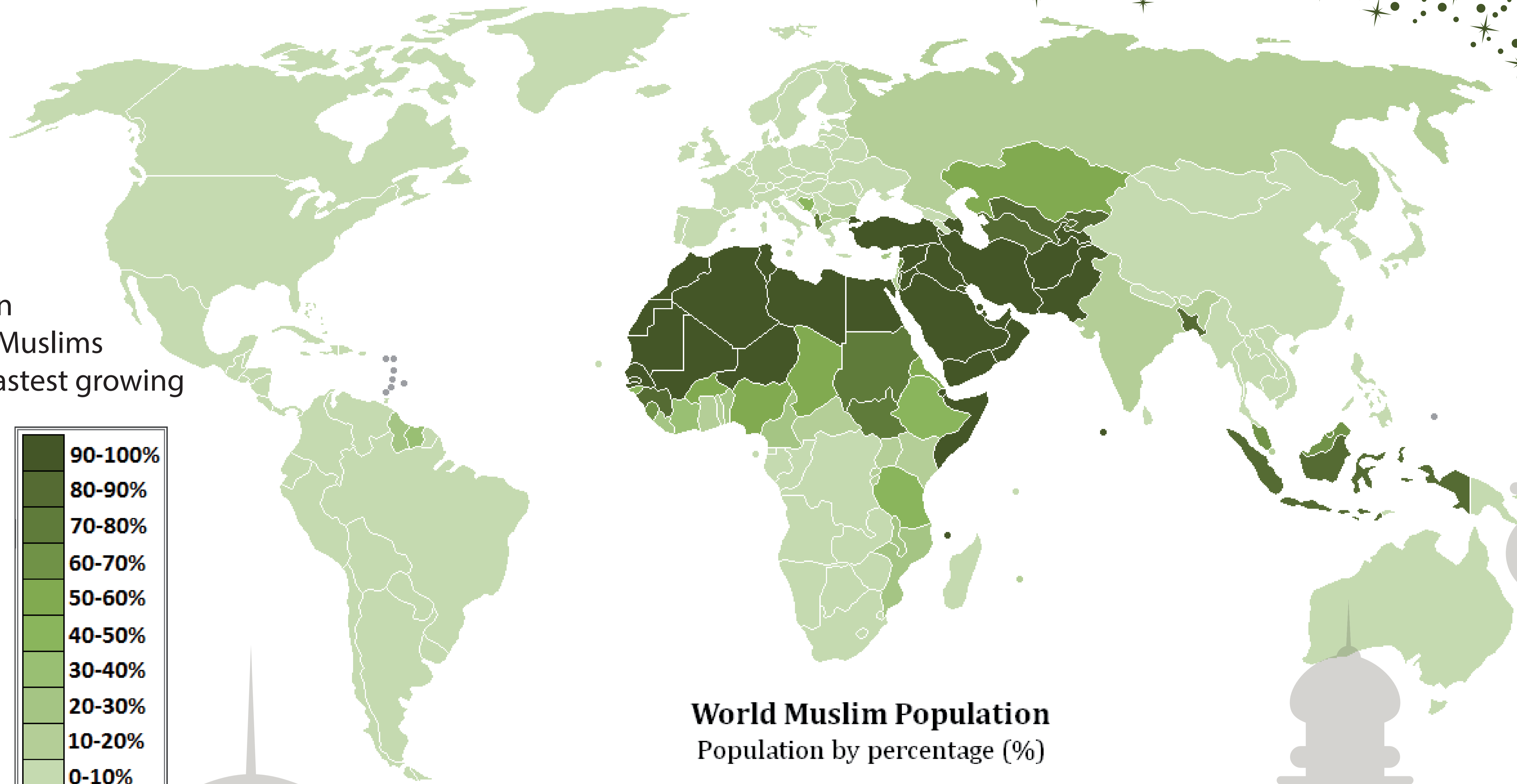
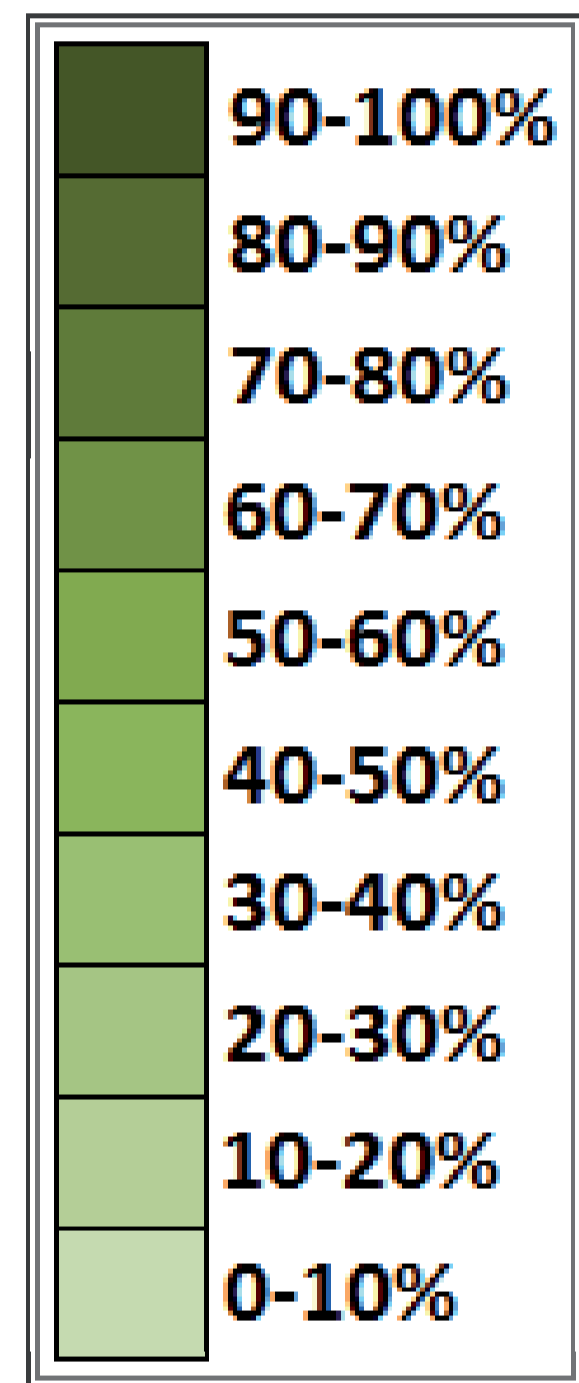


Islam all over the world

The Muslim world, also called Ummah is extremely diverse. according to figures from the United Nations Muslim population exceeded 1.6 billion by 2010. This is 25% of the world population. 62% of them live in Asia, 20% in the Middle East and North Africa, 15% in Sub-Saharan Africa, 3% in Europe and 0.3% in the Americas. Islam is the fastest growing religion and increases by more than 3% per year. Based on migration patterns, conversions and births of Muslims in Europe, Muslims will be 15% of the population. Islam is also one of the fastest growing religions in the United States.
